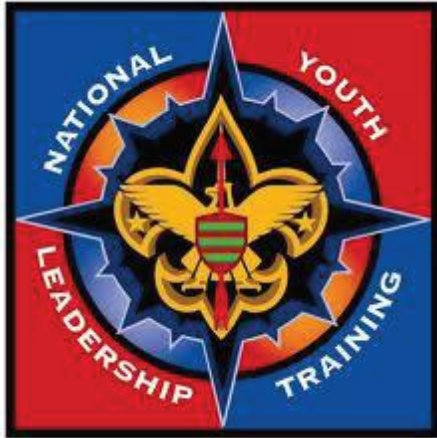

# National Youth Leadership Training

**July 8-14, 2012**

- *Be held at Camp Lindblad, Boulder Creek, California*
- *Have an orientation on May 19, 2012 at the Presidio in Monterey, California*

Training of the youth leaders of a unit is important in helping the individual Scout and the Troop or Crew grow. The Boy Scouts of America has developed a weeklong training experience that has proven very valuable in the training of youth leaders. The Alameda and Los Padres Councils are offering the NYLT Courses at Camp Lindblad, Boulder Creek, California for Boy Scouts, Venturers, and Varsity Scouts.

The Course will stress two areas of benefits to Youth leaders: (1) outdoor living skills and how they can be passed on to the other members of the troop or crew and patrol, and (2) the skills of leadership that will make the youth leader more effective in their job.

## What is National Youth Leadership Training?

National Youth Leadership Training is a seven-day outdoor experience for leaders in support of the Scoutmaster's or Advisor's responsibility for training of a troop's or crew's youth leaders. The course is set up to represent a month in the life of a typical troop or crew. Participants will sleep in tents, prepare their own meals by patrols, and will be expected to live by the Scout Oath and Law. Failure to do so may result in removal from camp.

## What is its purpose?

- To give Scouts and Venturers the confidence and knowledge to lead the troop program
- To give Scouts and Venturers a basic knowledge of the eleven skills of leadership and help them relate these skills to their troop or crew responsibilities.
- To give Scouts and Venturers the opportunity to share ideas and experiences with Scouts and Venturers from other locations.
- To create an atmosphere in which Scouts and Venturers will experience the patrol method at its best
- To enhance the relationship between the Scout or Venturer and his/her Scoutmaster or Advisor.
- To have Fun!

## Who may attend?

There is no unit restriction in attending this NYLT course. Participation in the program is on a "first come first served" basis. Boys and Girls attending the NYLT course will be participating in patrols formed of youth from throughout California. They will be placed in patrols with other youth they have not met prior to the course. It is highly recommended therefore, that each course participant be of sufficient maturity and experience as reflected in these requirements: Scouts must have achieved the rank of First Class and be 14 years old as of July 1, 2011. Both Scouts and Boy and Girl Venturers should have participated in a long term camp and should have a strong personal desire to attend the course.

## What are the dates and location of the Orientation and the Course?

A pre-course session and orientation will be held on Saturday May 19, 2012 from 8:45 AM to 3:30 PM at the Presidio of Monterey at the Scout Lodge located at Pvt Bolio Rd./Corporal Ewing Rd. and Lighthouse Ave. in Monterey, CA.

The NYLT course will be held at Camp Lindblad in the Santa Cruz Mountains. The address is 17660 Kings Creek Rd. Boulder Creek, CA. Participants will need to arrive for check-in at 10:00 AM on Sunday. The course will end on the following Saturday at 2:30 PM following graduation

## Are any other forms or special equipment required?

An equipment list will be provided at the Course Orientation. Most Scouts and Venturers in active troops or crews with good outdoor programs should have all the necessary gear. Each participant will be required to wear their official Field uniform (Class A), and ensure that badges are properly placed and that the uniform is worn correctly. Two activity uniform (Class B T-Shirts) will be provided.

Additional T-Shirts will be available at \$15 each.

Each participant must submit an Annual Health and Medical record prior to the course. No participant will be allowed without this form! If the scout is taking medication, then additional forms will be required.

## What not to bring!

- NO electronic devices - pagers; cell phone; radios, CD, DVD, MP3 players; iPods; etc.
- NO Troop or Crew T-Shirts - only NYLT T-Shirts may be worn.

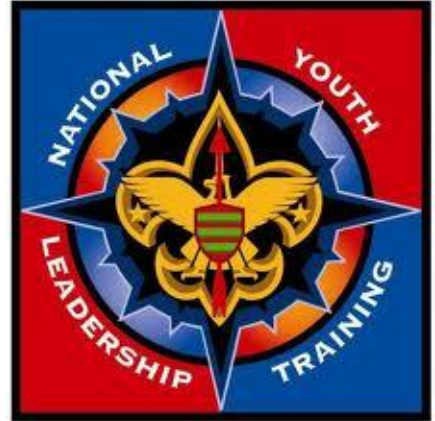
